


THE CONQUISTADOR'S WIFE

INSIGHT: MAKE NO ASSUMPTIONS

The great Toltec civilization thrived for nearly 1,000 years on the central plateau of Mexico. Their wisdom lives on today in "The Four Agreements." One of these teachings—Make No Assumptions—reminds us to be careful before we jump to conclusions about others...or ourselves.

Then, choose one of these stories and discuss the following questions with your family, classmates or friends:

1. What false conclusion did the storyteller come to about someone or something? Can you understand why they made that assumption?
2. How did discover they were wrong? What did this mistake cost them?
3. By the end of the story, what did they learn? What Insight did they gain about the situation...and themselves? Does their experience remind you of a time when you came to the wrong conclusion about something or someone? If so, how did you discover you were wrong? And what did you learn from your mistake?

Finally, choose one of these three ways to explore an incorrect conclusion YOU once made and the Insight this mistake gave you:

1. Write your own story of Insight in at least one full page.
2. Caption a photograph or do a piece of art work about Insight.
3. Tell your Insight story in your own short video.
