THE FOUR AGREEMENTS: MAKE NO ASSUMPTIONS - INSIGHT

One of these teachings—Make No Assumptions—reminds us to be careful before we jump to conclusions about others...or ourselves. - ♦ Tell your own story of Insight in writing and/or short video.
